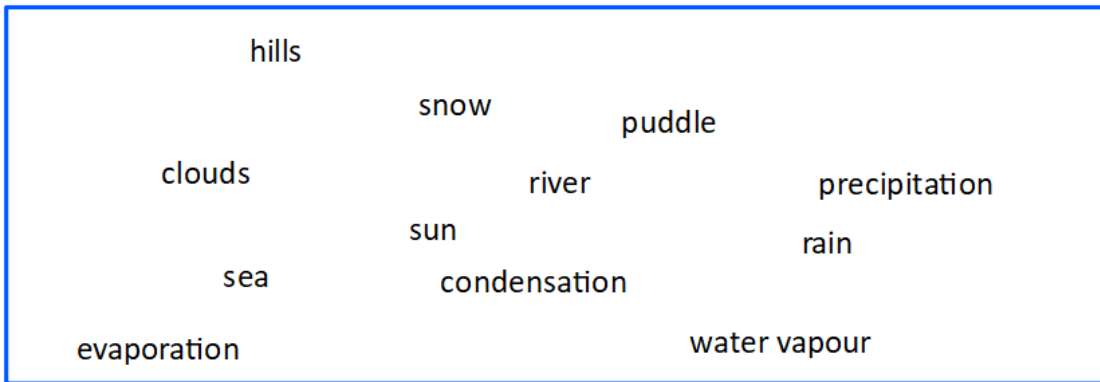
Prompts:
