Using the outline of the continent of Asia and your own knowledge, can you locate any countries, mountains, rivers or anything else?

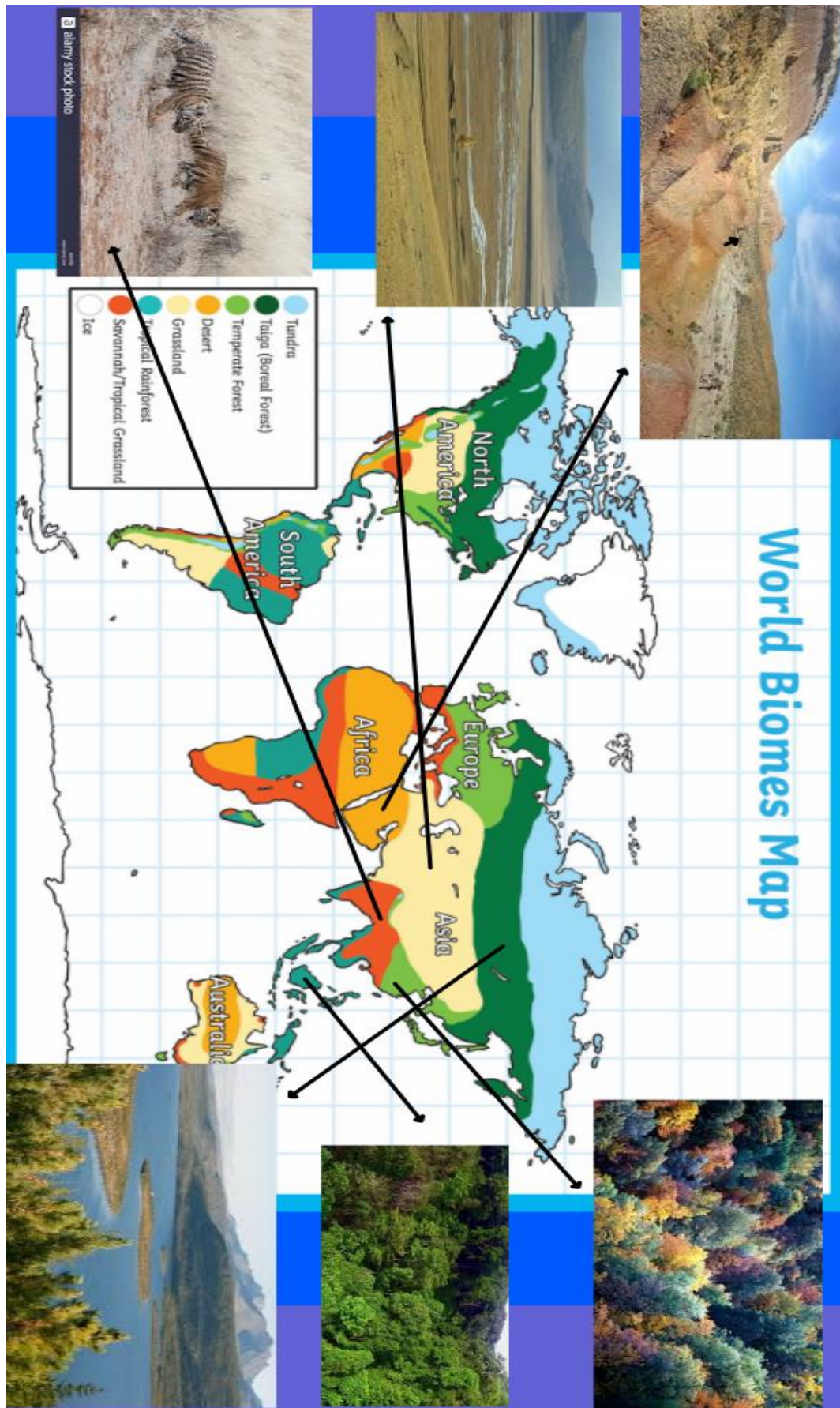

(see Everest near it, use 3D view as no street view)

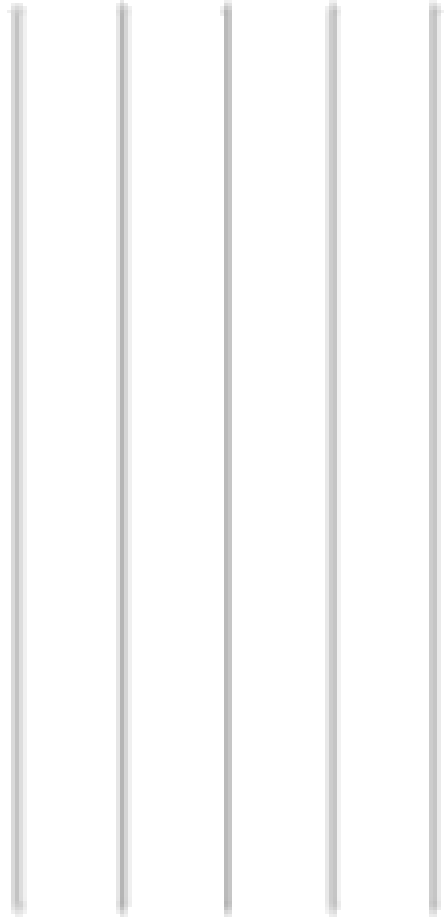
Raga Ampat Islands, Indonesia
