Activity 1:

You know have a setting and building. What's left is a character. Now imagine a character walking through the wood towards the building. Draw your character to add to your pop up book.



Activity 2:

To add to your pop up book, we need to add some text to explain what is happening. You are going to write a detailed paragraph using your word banks and ideas to tell us about your character entering the woods and finding the building. Think about what would they see, hear, smell, touch, taste? How would they feel?
