

LO: To recognise changes in our own environment

1) Environments change for a number of different reasons. Natural and man-made factors change an environment lots over time.

These two pictures are of the same place, Chandlers Ford Methodist Church, but they were taken 100 years apart.

In two different colours, write down what natural and man-made factors could have changed this environment. Think about the surrounding area, what has changed?



2) Changes to an environment can also happen on a much wider scale. The picture below shows the difference between New York City before people settled there, and how it looks today. This drastic change from a natural environment to a man-made environment is called **Urbanisation**.
