

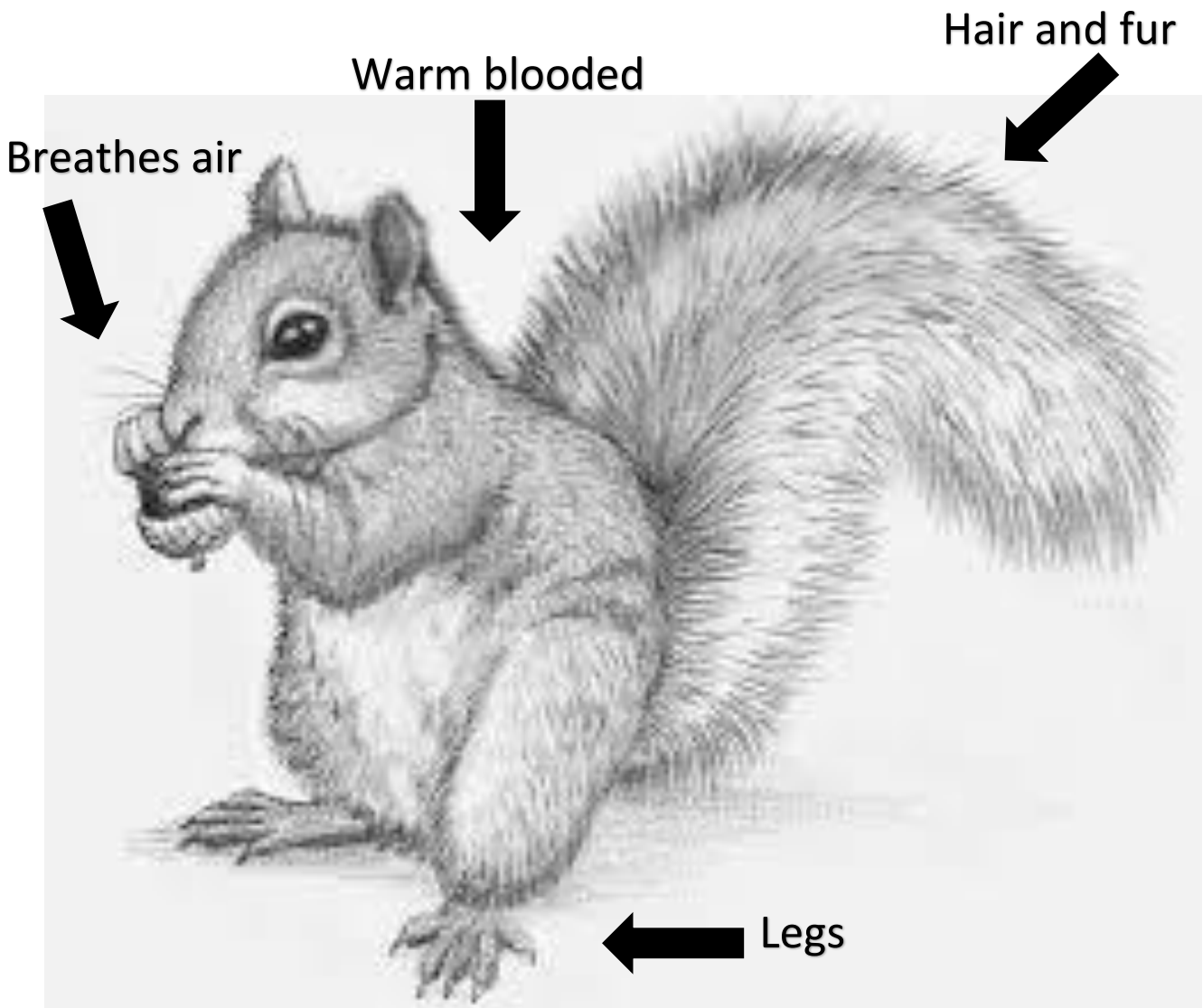
LO: To be able to explain why a living thing belongs to a particular classification group.
