

## Friday – Adverb identifying and using

### Activity 1:

Identify the adverbs in the descriptions below. (An adverb describes the verb, eg. The dog walked **slowly** down the path.)

#### The Horse-hair Stopper

"It's very simple," he said, "First you carefully take a few raisins. Then you soak them slowly overnight. Delicately, cut some horse hair into half-inch lengths. Very gently, push the horse hair into the soft raisin. Spread the raisins randomly over the area you are hunting and then you can catch the pheasants."

#### The Sticky Hat

"First of all, you carefully dig a hole in the ground. Then gently twist some paper into the hole to make a cup shape. Spread some glue evenly around the cup sides and delicately drop three raisins inside. Cunningly leave a trail of raisins leading to the cup."

### Activity 2:

Using an adverb in each line, write instructions for one of the pheasant catching methods. Here is an example so that you know what I am looking for!

1) Carefully, take a few raisins.

2) Slowly, soak them overnight.

3) Delicately, cut some horse-hair into half-inch lengths.

4) Gently, push the horse-hair into the raisin.

5) Randomly, spread the raisins over the hunting area.
