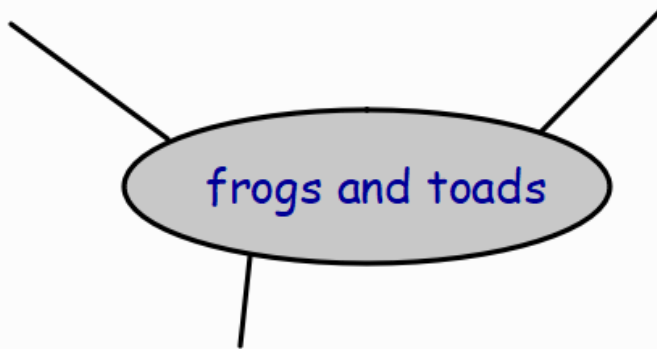


Activity 1
