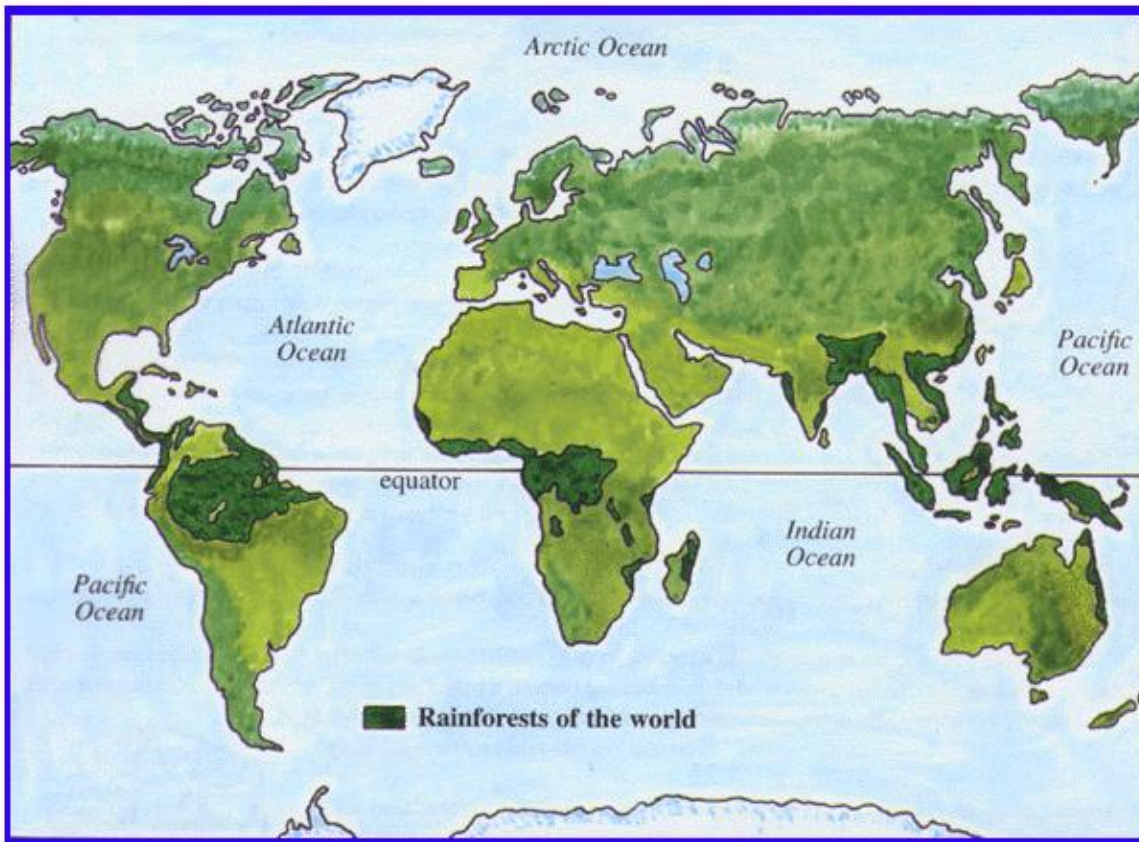
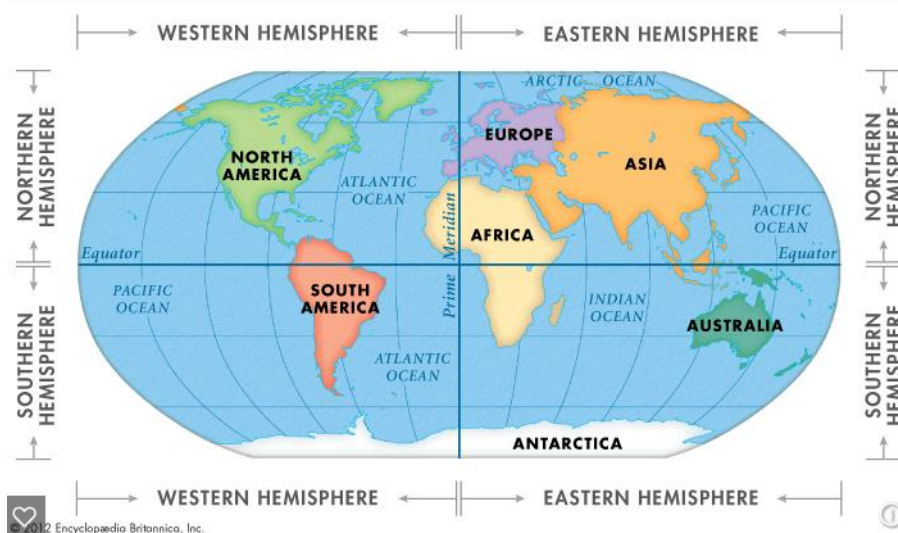


Wednesday - The Location of the Rainforests Pattern

The Equator is an imaginary line drawn around the Earth. Land around the Equator is very warm all year round due to the way the Earth spins around the sun. What do you notice about the location of the rainforests in relation to the equator? Can you explain why this might be the case?
