# Curriculum Overview w Year 4



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## Spring Term 2019 "Australia is all the same!"

This term we are looking at a Geography based topic. We are learning about where Australia is, its size and the key aspects of settlements and land use. We will explore the theory that all Australia is the same by researching the different territories and comparing them geographically. Our English text is all about a stoat's adventure in the beautiful city of Sydney.

### English

In English, we will be basing our learning on the story of 'The Travels Of Ermine – Stoat on Stage', a funny tale with references to Australian concepts and the landscape of Sydney. We will be using this within our English work to focus on persuasive writing in many different forms. We will be writing postcards from characters, conversations between characters, newsflash reports and travel website pages.

### PSHE

This half term the focus will be on how we can keep ourselves safe outside the school environment.

Our IGNITE value is "Initiator" so we will be analysing and improving our ability to solve problems, breaking them down into small steps, looking at problems in a variety of different ways, and working as a team.

### Maths

This term we will start by learning about how to calculate the area of two dimensional shapes. We will then complete a unit learning about fractions – exploring different fractions, learning how to calculate fractions of numbers and shapes and ordering fractions. We will then move on to learning about decimals, learning the decimal equivalents of common fractions and how to add and subtract decimal numbers.

### Knowledge & Understanding

**Science-** We will continue our habitat longitudinal study of our chosen area in the copse. We also will complete a unit on Sound, learning how sounds travels and how we hear sounds.

**ICT-** We will be making databases about Australian marsupials and creating animations about them too.



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### Physical Education (PE)

This half– term in Year 4 we are continuing to focus on the skills and tactics in rugby. In our indoor session we are doing a gymnastics unit.
