They will have the next four weeks to complete it. Completed projects should be brought to school by Friday 29th March 2019. The tasks below have been compiled using the children’s own suggestions, so we hope that this is an enjoyable experience for both you and your child!

It is your child’s choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be creative and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks (no larger than A3 size please!)

- Draw and label a map of Australia
- Make an Australian food
- Make a collage of Australian pictures and label with information
- Find out about the Australian flag and what each features represents
- Paint an Australian landscape picture
- Find out about a city in Australia
- Explore the distances between places in Australia
- Research a native Australian animal
- Make a board game to teach your friends about Australia
- Find out about the discovery of Australia
- Make a travel brochure about Australia
- If you have an idea that is not on the list, then please use this option to complete an activity of your own choice!
