They will have the next four weeks to complete it. Completed projects should be brought to school by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019. The tasks below have been compiled using the children’s own suggestions, so we hope that this is an enjoyable experience for both you and your child!

It is your child’s choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be creative and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks (no larger than A3 size please!)

- Design and make a weapon, helmet or a shield
- Presentation about the Anglo-Saxons
- Research and create a presentation about food of Anglo-Saxon times
- Buildings in Anglo-Saxon times
- Clothing of Anglo-Saxons (3D model of a person)
- Diary of an Anglo-Saxon
- Board game about Anglo-Saxons
- Portrait of significant Anglo-Saxon and explanation
- Long boat of Anglo-Saxon
- Map of where Anglo – Saxons lived
- Visit the King Alfred statue in Winchester
- Visit the Winchester Museum
