‘From the Land of the Frost Giants’

This half term our topic is called “From the Land of the Frost Giants”. The children will be able to construct their own opinions about whether the Vikings were warriors, raiders, settlers or even a mixture of each! To bring history to life and inspire their creativity we will start with an exploration of Viking remains! We will then continue with a range of practical and informative lessons exploring Viking invasion and settlement in Britain. Throughout the half term, across the curriculum, we will be exploring the IGNITE learning value of Independence?

English

In English this half term we will be focusing on a range of writing linked to our curriculum topic which will enable the children to apply their knowledge and research within a range of genres. We will begin by exploring creative writing through character, setting and atmosphere. Our writing will be driven through our class text-Odd and the Frost Giants. We will also look at non-fiction writing as well as writing in a range of genres. We will be applying our weekly spelling rule daily,

PSHE

We will be exploring the theme ‘Risks and Pressures’. The children will learn to face new challenges positively by collecting information, looking for help, making responsible choices and taking action.

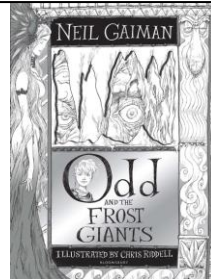
Maths

The children will begin this term rehearsing and developing their mathematical skills linked to the four operations and place value. This will help them to secure their understanding of the methods for the four operations and then applying them to a range of problem solving situations.

Creative Curriculum

Science- This unit explores ‘Properties and changes of materials’. The children will group and compare a variety of materials based on their properties. They will also use their knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to separate mixtures and discover which are reversible and those which are irreversible.

Music – In music the children will learn about the concept of Leitmotiv and will be able to compose their own music theme for their chosen Norse God.
