

<b>Year Group: 5</b> <b>Name of project: It's all Greek to me!</b> <b>Term: Summer 1</b>		
<b>Our learning overview</b> This half term our main history topic is called 'It's all Greek to me!'. We will be examining the impact of the Ancient Greeks upon modern life. In science, we will focussing on forces and how they can be observed and manipulated.	<b>Summary of current hook:</b> The children will visit Southampton City Art Gallery to learn about Ancient Greek art and support our work on the myth of Medusa.	<b>Summary of current celebration:</b> We will be inviting parents in to share a reading of our myths.
<b>History:</b> The children will be learning about all aspects of Ancient Greece, from debate and democracy to Gods, myths and the Olympics! To bring History to life and inspire their creativity we will by explore the great myths and monsters of Ancient Greece through stories such as Perseus and Medusa; Theseus and the Minotaur. <b>Art:</b> Art this half term will all be inspired by the Greek myths, for example we will make Medusa heads and tiles and clay pots. <b>Science:</b> In Science we will be investigating Forces, including gravity, air and water resistance and friction. <b>English:</b> In English we will be continuing to read Wolf Brother, and write survival instructions, as well as tense action scenes for narrative. <b>Maths:</b> We will be looking at decimals, in place value and calculation, as well as looking at negative numbers, and converting units. <b>PE:</b> In PE we will be preparing for sports day by learning athletic techniques as well as revising our ball striking skills in cricket, tennis and rounders.	<b>RSE</b> Growing and Changing identify the changes that happen through puberty to allow sexual reproduction to occur;	<b>Outdoor Learning</b> We will be using the copse for our outcome reading myths and the grounds to explore forces in science
