Our Learning Overview

This half term we will be asking the question, **What unites the nations of the United Kingdom?**
 We will be exploring the similarities and differences between the four nations that make the United Kingdom.

Summary of current hook:

The children will be introduced to the new topic during the first week. They will take part in a range of activities which will include considering their ideas about what the United Kingdom looks like and creating a layered map.

Summary of current celebration:

The Children will create an exhibition of Art work inspired by artists and designers from the four nations.

Geography (including outdoor learning) Locate the UK within the world, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries, and major cities
 Explain and identify human and physical features
 Locate features on a map using 4 figure grid references
 Compare the climate of different areas of the UK by interpreting charts and graphs. Compare the different types of landscapes within the UK
Science-Digestion- How does the body get nutrients from food into the bloodstream?
Art – Artist and Designers from the 4 nations of the United Kingdom, learning about the artists and designers and the different techniques they use.
Music– This term in music will be concentrating on singing building up to our performance in the Carol Concert
RE – Christmas: The Annunciation (visit of the Angel Gabriel to Mary to announce the Incarnation).
Computing – Photo editing
PE – Badminton and Tag Rugby. PE days are Monday and Thursday.
