What does the mystery of the empty grave tell us about Saxon Britain?  How did people's lives change when Christianity came to Britain and how can we be sure?  How were the Saxons able to see off the Viking threat?  Why was Winchester so important to Anglo-Saxons? What evidence remains there today?  Just how great was King Alfred, really?  Were the Anglo-Saxons invaders or settlers? How can we justify our opinions?</p> <p><b>Science</b>  <b>Plants – Reproduction</b>  •Flowering plants have evolved to carry out pollination, fertilisation and seed growth.  •Seed dispersal improves chances of enough seeds germinating and growing to mature plants.  •Seeds and bulbs need the right conditions to germinate.
