

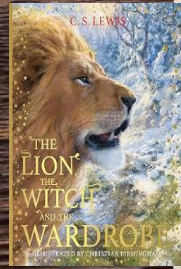
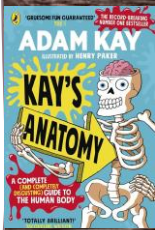
Autumn Two in Year 4



English

In English we will be using Neil Gaiman's text called 'Instructions' to inspire our own instructions on how to survive a quest in a fairy tale world. We will then move on to reading Ted Hughes' 'The Iron Man' to inspire our writing.

We are reading...



In reading we will be reading non-fiction texts about digestion and exploring the children's classic, 'The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe.'

Maths

In maths this half term we will be learning all about fractions! Including recognizing and showing families of equivalent fractions, counting in 100ths and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.

Art

We will be learning about the great artist Adrien Berg and understand the historical and cultural development of his paintings. We will learn skills of watercolour painting to create our own paintings of reflections.

Science

We will be learning all about disgusting digestion! We will find out about how the digestive system works, including how food is absorbed and excreted, the teeth and their functions, food chains and the transfer of energy.



French

In French we be learning the vocabulary of weather and describing the seasons as well as explaining our favourite season.

Geography

This term in Geography we will be comparing Chandlers Ford to a town in Europe. We will focus on various forms of Geography, including human, economic, and physical. We will use maps to explore the two regions and make comparisons as well as making use of digital geography platforms.

Music

In music we will be finishing our learning about pulse (beats) and rhythm. Our new topic will then be singing! We will practise singing in a round, and preparing for the Carol Concert.

RE

In RE, we will be learning about Incarnation, with a focus on Christianity and the Christian belief of God made into man.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about the importance of respect during Anti-Bullying Week and exploring strategies to be a good friend and deal with conflict.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning the skills of photo editing, exploring how images can be changed and re-touched. We will practise how to change the composition of images through cropping, changing colours and replicating parts of an image. We will also look at fake images.

PE

In PE we will be learning the skills needed in the game of Badminton, including striking using a variety of strokes, game play and tactics. We will also be practising Tag Rugby and catching and throwing skills.
