- A model.

- The history of the New Forest-The Story of King Rufus.
- A piece of Art- this can be in any medium.
- A record of a trip to the New Forest: a diary, a visual record through photographs or film.
- Go to the New Forest and make some land art and photograph it- see Andy Goldsworthy's work
- Why are National Parks important? An environmental study.
- If you have an idea that is not on the list, then please use this option to complete an activity of your own choice!

Please make sure all posters are no bigger than A3 and model the size of a shoe box. We can't wait to see these so get working on your first piece of the year!
