This half term, year 4 will be looking at the geography of the UK and the food that it produces. We would like your child to select either a task from the list below or an idea of their own. They will have the next five weeks to complete it. The tasks below have been compiled using the children’s own suggestions, so we hope that this is an enjoyable experience for both you and your child!

It is your child’s choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be creative and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks (no larger than A3 size please!)

- Model of the UK.
- Sculpture of a famous building.
- Make a meal.
- Drawing of food or a location.
- Draw a map of Britain.
- A fact file of the UK or foods.
- Create a poster about UK food.
- Advertisement for the UK and the food it produces.
- A model of the Union Jack.
- Information about the different patron saints of each UK country.
- Film a cookery demonstration.
- Research about different sports which originate in the UK.
- Design or make your ideal restaurant.
- Or another idea of your own choice!

We can’t wait to see these and we will be creating a Home Learning display in the next week, so get working on your first piece! We would ask that all Home Learning is completed and handed into class by **Wednesday 16th May** so that children have the opportunity to vote for their favourite. We would also like to keep some longer so that we can display them in and around the school for all to see!
