Autumn 1 2017 Wild at Heart

This term we are looking at the science topic of Habitats. We will be learning about how different food chains occur in different habitats and comparing those in the UK and Africa. We will also be learning about the natural disasters which cause environmental changes and how they affect different habitats.

English

Our English learning this term will be based on the Michael Morpurgo novel 'The Butterfly Lion'. We will be using the text to explore the themes of captivity and freedom.

The children will be writing a variety of texts including a narrative, a non-fiction text and a diary.

As part of our Wild at Heart topic we will also be creating a leaflet about comparing habitats in the UK to Africa.

PSHE

We will be exploring the topic 'Changes in Families'. This topic will address different types of relationships and families and what they provide us with. We will also be learning about the changes that take place in human life.

Music

This term the children are learning to play brass instruments

Maths

We will begin this term by learning about place value which will include ordering numbers and learning the value of each digit. This will then lead into calculation practice which we will apply through measurement. Finally we be learning about geometry looking closely at symmetrical shapes.

Alongside these topics we will also be continuing to learn our times tables. Please help your child in these areas, by practising them whenever and wherever you can!

Knowledge & Understanding

Science

As mentioned above this half term is a science led topic on habitats and comparing how different animals live around the world.

ICT

We will begin this term by refreshing our E-safety learning. We will be moving on to learn how to use, sort and interrogate databases. This will be followed by creating habitat quizzes in Scratch.
