Summer 1 2018 'Precious Places'

This term our topic will be 'Precious Places', looking near and to our local environment for inspiration. We will be looking at what makes these places special and how we can all play a part in taking care of these places.

English-

We will start the topic by spending time in our special place – the copse. Our writing will focus on presenting a clear point of view using persuasive language. We will be considering our audience and writing in a more formal way. Our next writing focus will be learning how to write a newspaper article using a film stimulus.

We will continue with our weekly spelling focus and work on being responsible for checking our own writing.

PSHE-

Keeping Safe in School -

We will be looking at how we all contribute to making our school environment safe. This will include discussing bullying, cyber safety, road safety and being safe around medicines.



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Maths

In maths we will be continuing to use addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to solve problems involving a range of measures. We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes. We are continuing to develop our understanding of fractions.

Our tables focus, as well as reviewing 2, 5, 10 3, 4 times table, will extend to the 8x table.

This term, we will continue to work on telling the time – please practise this at home too.

Science- We will be linking this with our work in the outdoor classroom and growing plants; considering what they need to be healthy.

ICT- We will be using different art packages to create art in the style of David Hockney's photo collages. We will also be creating algorithms for everyday events.

Physical Education (PE)

We will be outdoors improving our striking and fielding skills through a variety of games and building our team games strategies. We will also be practising our athletic skills.

Music – We will be playing samba rhythms and creating our own Rainforest sound scape. Our theme will link to Precious Places through the Rainforest.
