These tasks have been compiled using the children’s own suggestions, so we hope that this is an enjoyable experience for you and your child! Your child should pick one task over the half term to complete.

It is your child’s choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be creative and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. (No bigger than A3 please). Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks

- Spend a day in the outdoors. Can you make your own shelter? What will you eat? Make a photo diary to share with the class.
- Make a Stone Age tool.
- Visit a Stone Age/Iron Age location and write about your visit or make a photo diary. (Stonehenge or another local location)
- Create a stone model/collage of yourself! Bring a photo of it into school.
- Write a letter as though you are living in the Stone Age/Iron Age which is being read by someone now! You could be U!
- Make a Stone Age or Iron Age scene in a shoe box
- Create a pattern made out of stones (Take a photo of it and bring it to school)
- Make a model of what a Stone Age/Iron Age village might look like.
- If you have an idea that is not on the list, then please use this option to complete an activity of your own choice!

We can’t wait to see these and we look forward to sharing them with the class. We would ask that all Home Learning is completed and handed into class by 11th October so that children have the opportunity to vote for their favourite. The chosen work from each year group will be on display in the hall after school on 16th October from 3.30pm onwards.
