Your child should pick one task over this half term to complete. These tasks have been compiled using the children's own suggestions, so we hope that this is an enjoyable experience for you and your child!

It is your child's choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be creative and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks

- Find out about food in a European country. Find and make a recipe from the country. Bring it in or take photographs of you making it.
- Make a poster to persuade people to visit a European country of your choice. What makes the country special?
- Make a map of a route you often travel through. It could be 2D or 3D.
- Create a collage of European landmarks or flags.
- Create a new story for Traction Man. Could be handwritten, recorded, typed or cartoon strip.
- Design a new outfit for Traction Man – explain why he is dressed in the way that you have designed.
- Write a diary "A Day in the Life of _____" (super hero of your choice! You could be the superhero from Hook Day)
- Design and make a meal for a superhero – what would they need to eat to boost their superpowers?
- Create and record some superhero music or write a song.
- If you have an idea that is not on the list, then please use this option to complete an activity of your own choice!

We would ask that all Home Learning is completed and handed into class by Wednesday 13th December so that children have the opportunity to vote for their favourite. The chosen work from each year group will be on display in the hall after school on Wednesday 20th December 2017 at 3.30pm.
