Your child should pick **one task** over the next term to complete.

It is your child's choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be creative and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks.

- Make a 2D or 3D map of your journey to school.
- Have a trip out, follow a map and record your adventures. (This could be a diary or a photo story).
- Plan a cycle route around your area. Try it out and present your findings.
- Create a menu of wild foods you can eat to survive if you were stranded on a wooded island.
- Write a diary as an explorer in a remote area.
- Research a famous explorer, present you findings creatively.
- Create a shelter and write about what you did – you could even test it out.
- Plan a trip around the world. How would your travel? What places would be on your 'must see' list?
- Design and make a mode of transport to take you on a journey around the world.
- Anything else you are interested in finding out about.
