The key stage 2 tests are timetabled from Monday 9 May to Thursday 12 May 2022.

KS2 Year 6 SATs Dates - May 2022

Date	Test
Monday 9th May 2022	Grammar & Punctuation test - 45 minutes Spelling Test - 20 minutes
Tuesday 10th May 2022	English Reading Test - 60 minutes
Weds 11th May 2022	Mathematics Arithmetics (Paper 1) - 30 minutes Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 2) - 40 minutes
Thurs 12th May 2022	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes

We will use past papers to practice so the children are familiar with the tests and how to answer question.

We will have practise weeks on the following dates

6th December 2021

14th February 2022

Final mock week 4th April 2022
