Your child should pick one task during the next few weeks of learning to complete to a high standard. These tasks have been compiled using some of the children’s own suggestions, so we hope that this is an enjoyable experience for you and your child!

It is your child’s choice which activity they choose. They should spend some time to be **creative** and thoughtful in their approach and presentation. We would ask that Home Learning should be completed with care, and this should be reflected in what they present/create. Please feel free to give your child support and ideas with these tasks and encourage their **creativity**.

- Creative animal art (2D or 3D – real or made up animal). What facts do you know about your animal?
- Make an animal feeder for your own garden. Bring in your observations/photos of the wildlife it attracts. (Please do not bring in the feeder)
- Choose a habitat and explore the animals which live there. (eg ocean, desert, rainforest etc)
- Listen to the suite of music ‘Carnival of Animals’ How could you respond to this? Art/ Poetry/Story/Create your own piece to accompany and animal.
- Visit a place with lots of animals. Creatively share the experience with the class. (Think habitats and food the animals need).
- Read a story about Wolves and find a creative way to share the story with others.
- Prepare a presentation on the differences between creatures with exoskeletons and endoskeletons or no skeleton.
- Make a moving skeleton model (not too big)
- If you have an idea that is not on the list, then please use this option to complete an activity of your own choice! The theme of Inside Us covers animals and humans, skeletons and nutrition.
