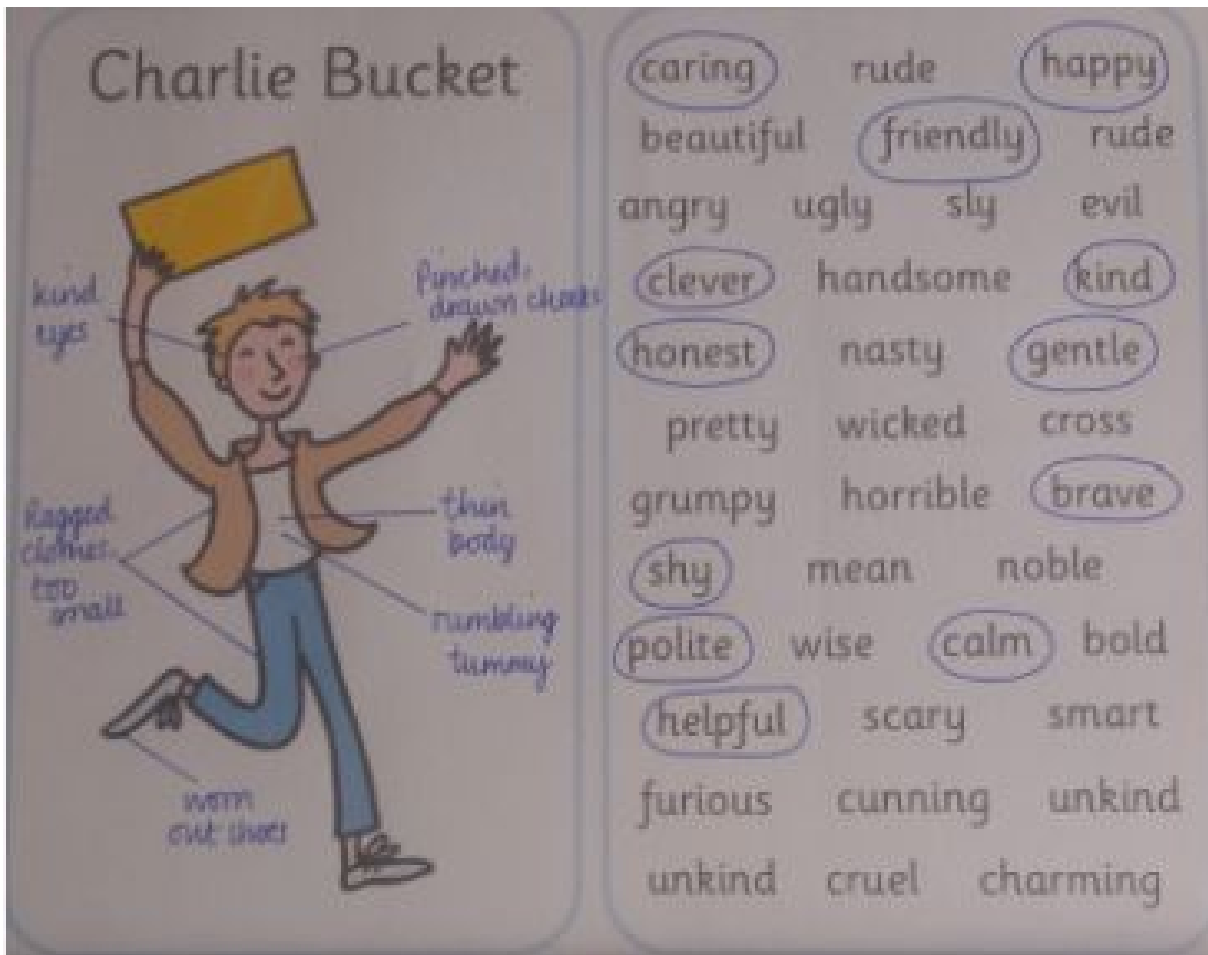


Writing Week 6, activity 4 - description ideas WAGOLL
