Sweets



In a restaurant, the waiter brings you a menu for you to make your choices.

We are going to create a Word Waiter to collect lots of super word ideas and, later in the week, use it to choose words to make our poem.

We are going to collect 3 types of words...

Nouns : Sweets. Things you can see or imagine would be in a sweet shop.

Adjectives : Words to describe sweets. Let your imagination run wild with ideas. You might use a thesaurus (there are some online)

Onomatopoeia : These are words that mean the sound they make. Eg whoosh, drip, ping.
