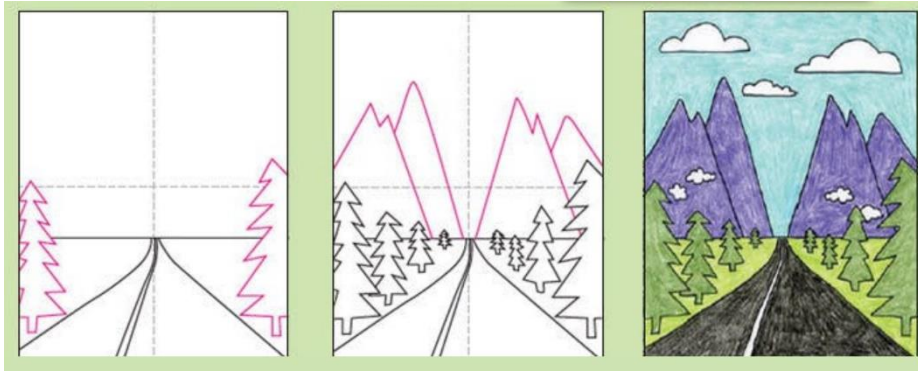


Art in the Style of David Hockney



1. Lightly, draw a grid on your page. Mine is A5; half an A4 page.



5. After that, draw more trees. Remember they need to get smaller as they get further away.



2. Next, draw in your horizon and add a road. It could be straight or wavy but needs to get narrower as it gets further away.



7. The next task is to add the details. What can you see I have added?



3. Carefully, add trees on either side of the road. The ones at the front will be the biggest because they are closest.



8. Taking your time, colour your picture. How can you make it look really neat? What colours will you choose?



4. In the distance, add the hills and mountains.



9. Finally, you can add an outline if you wish.
