



Safeguarding procedures at Merdon Junior School

At Merdon Junior School, we highly value the safeguarding and well-being of our children and staff. Our Safeguarding policy requires all staff and volunteers to be DBS checked.

A DBS check is a record of a person's criminal convictions and cautions and is carried out by the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS).

It's an essential requirement for those working around children or vulnerable adults

At Merdon, we require all visitors to wear lanyards once they have signed in.

Visitors who have had their original DBS checked by a member of staff, will be issued with a **BLUE** lanyard.

Visitors who have not shown proof of an original DBS, will be issued with a **GREEN** lanyard. They will be supervised by a member of staff at ALL times.
