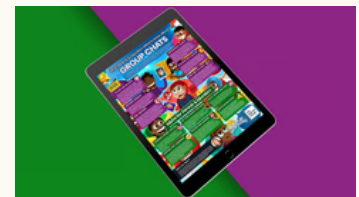
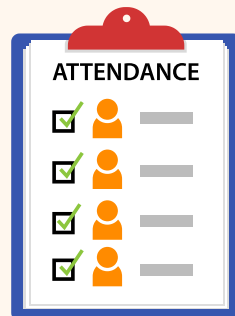

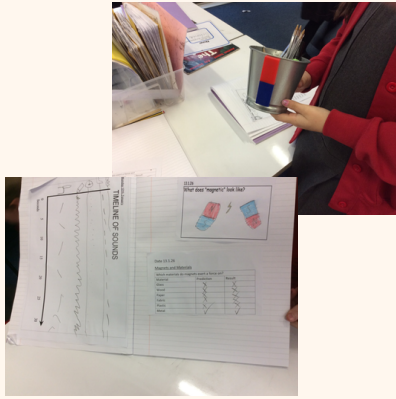

On Thursday 26th February at 2.00p.m. we will be hosting a parent workshop with the Primary Behaviour Service - flyer to follow.



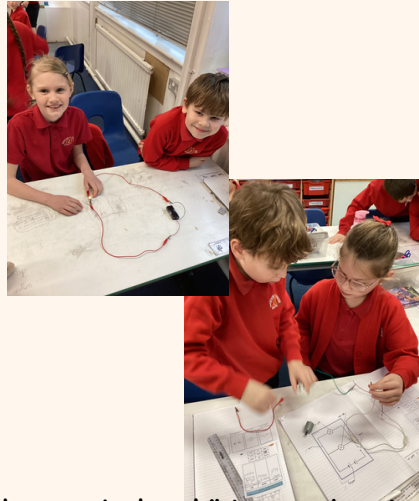
Our Learning this fortnight
