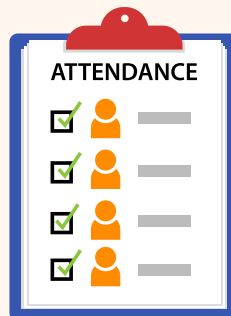

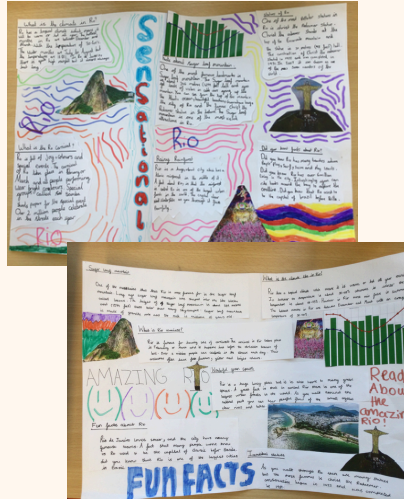
Our Learning this fortnight
